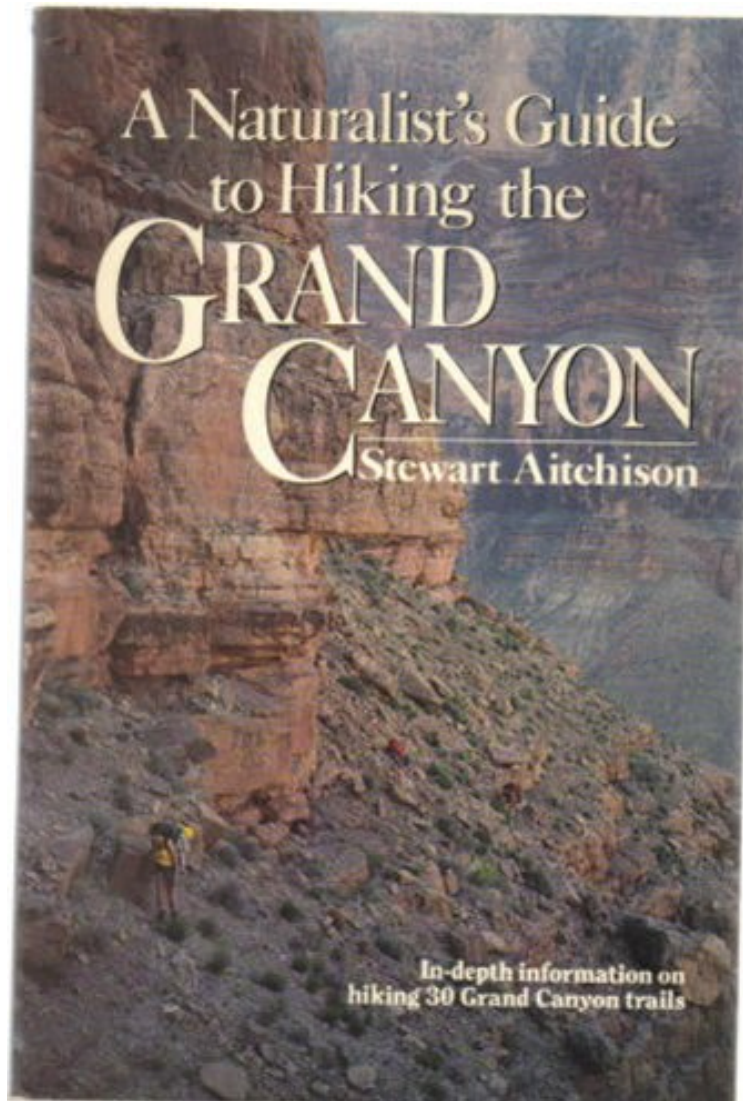

There are photocopies of topographic maps along with plain and concise descriptions of the nature and history of each trail. If you can get a copy, just keep in mind thatA) access issues have changed, in a number of places*, andB) the author

assumes top fitness in the reader, and some willingness to scramble, if not actually downclimb. So, be realistic about your own abilities. *PS of 2013: changes have been particularly drastic in the Hualapai Rez; this area has been, for some time, all but off-limits for anyone other than those engaged in major money making. Check the author's description and wish it were otherwise.
