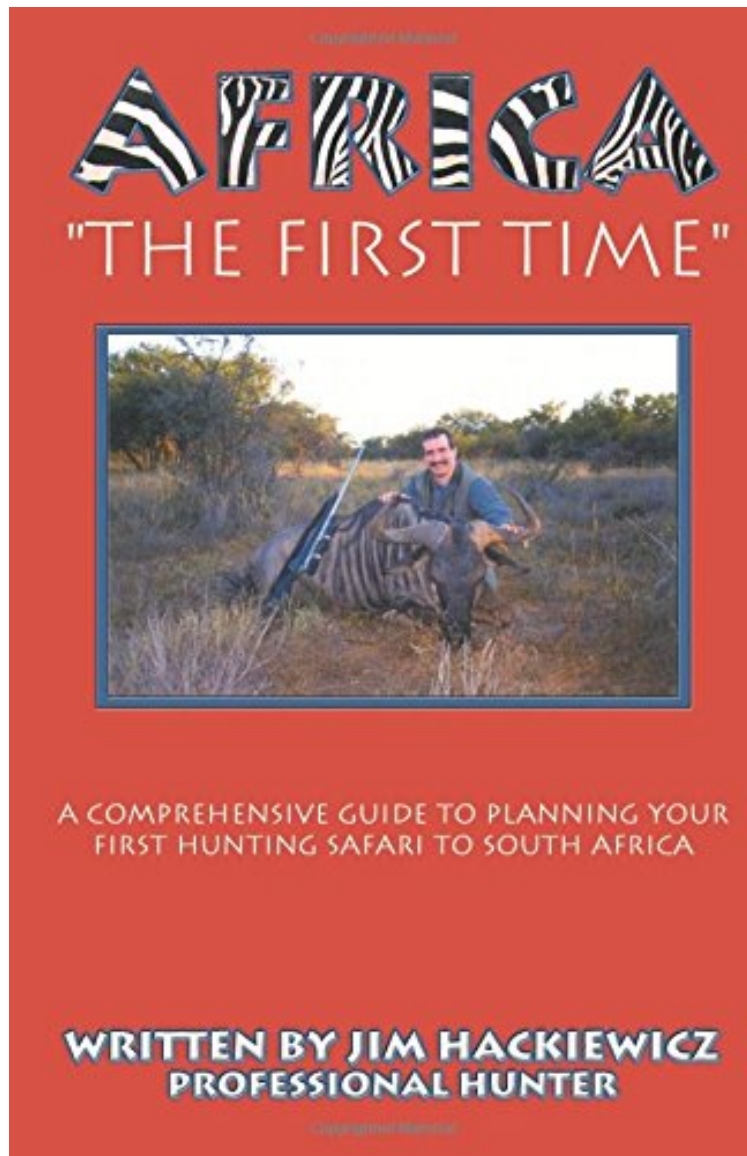

website ([...])The author, who has worked as a PH (Professional Hunter) in Africa for several years, writes in a friendly and engaging way. There are 20 short chapters, dealing with weather, clothing, health concerns, money, and specifics on travelling with firearms (very important), as well as equipment, the legendary toughness of African game, daily routine on safari and taxidermy. There is also a short suggested reading list. Some of this information is available on his website and more can be gleaned by reading African hunting websites such as [...] or the African Hunting section of Graybeard Outdoors (of which the author is the moderator), but it is nonetheless very useful to have this no-nonsense practical guide in a written, easy-to-read form. My only quibble is that it ought to have been properly proof-read before going to press, as there are quite a few grammatical errors and typos. At only 57 pages it is also quite a slim volume for the price, but this is perhaps to be expected, given that it caters to quite fairly small readership, so the printing costs will be relatively high to start with. (And of course a safari is not an inexpensive endeavour, either!) Those small concerns aside, I would recommend it as good basic reading for anyone planning a safari for the first time.
