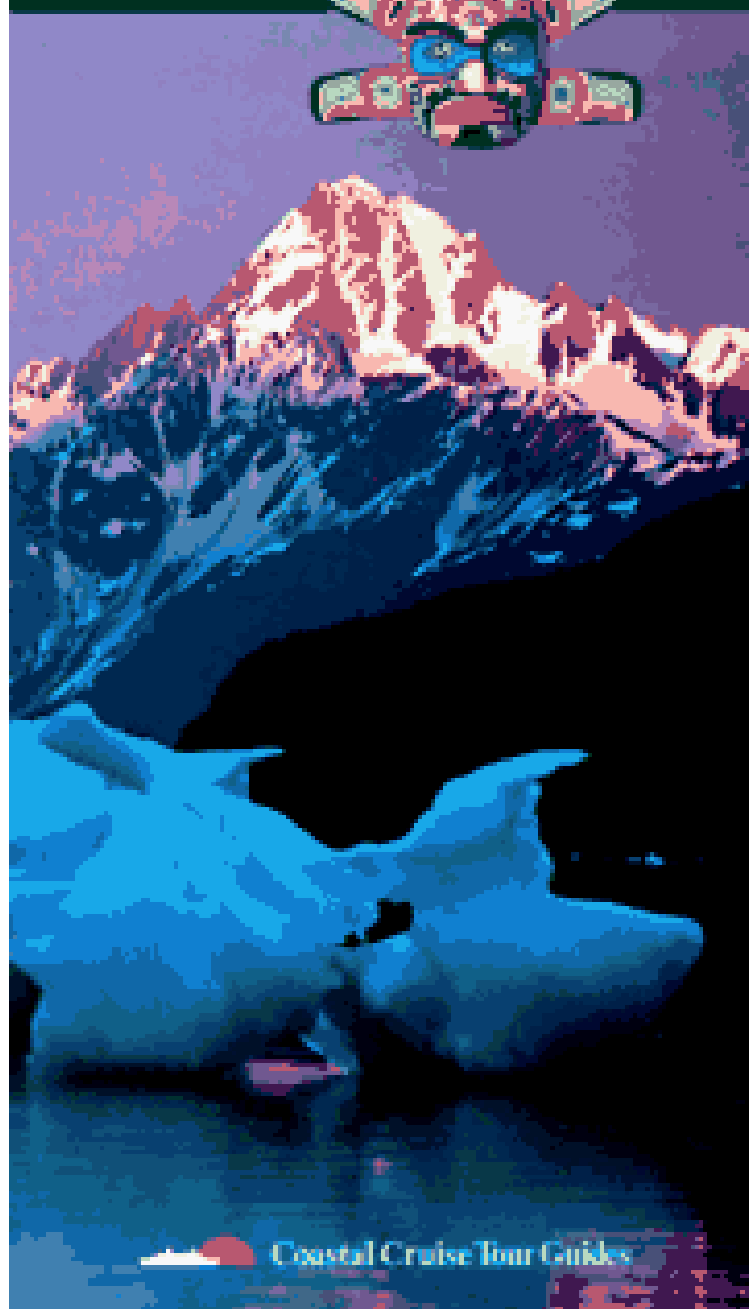

Poor quality printingBy SoloviajeroThis map may be okay as something you carry along on a big boat cruise ship, but it's not suitable at all, even as a planning map, for a self-guided cruise in a smaller boat. I didn't expect a navigation map, but I did expect one that was readable, which my copy wasn't. The blue of the water and the green of the land are both printed very dark, and the oertext is printed in black, making it a chore to distinguish the land from the water, and a chore to read the text. A young person with keen vision and good ability to distinguish similar shades of green and blue might not have a problem, but an older person with lesser vision would have considerable difficulty. Perhaps my specimen was just badly printed. The content is quite superficial, though it may be adequate as a cruise souvenir for very light use. You can find a much better quality map of the Inside Passage on , printed by FineEdge.com, which is larger and much more useful as a map, but does not contain the superficial descriptions of flora and fauna.8 of 8 people found the following review helpful.
