It has a calendar and tide charts that would have been nice, perhaps even useful in 1998, but are now worthless. The book also contains "over \$250 in savings" coupons that expired over two years ago.It remains to be seen if the featured attractions, restaurants and businesses are still operating. I will check it out this summer.I recommend a pass on this item. Look for something more current.

A valuable source of detailed information regarding south central Alaska areas. As far north as Denali National Park, to Paxson (north east), Valdez and Cordova (south east), with the entire Matanuska-Susitna valleys (central) and the Kenai Peninsula (south west), the guide offers a full descriptive and history of each city, town, village and main locations,including facilities and services, and a list of activities and attractions illustrated with colored pictures. In addition to the addresses, phone numbers and geographical locations, you will find tide tables of all coastal towns, descriptive of local mammals, birds, fish, and flowers, 58 hiking trails summarized, city maps, entire area road maps and a full detailed mile chart.

From the AuthorWe are the only specialized travel guide editor for the south central Alaska region, and the only one offering so many detail information at a reasonable cost and in a convenient size book (4.5 inch. x 8.5 inch.). A great investment that will save you money (with coupons included) and that local residents or tourists may use all year-round for reference.
