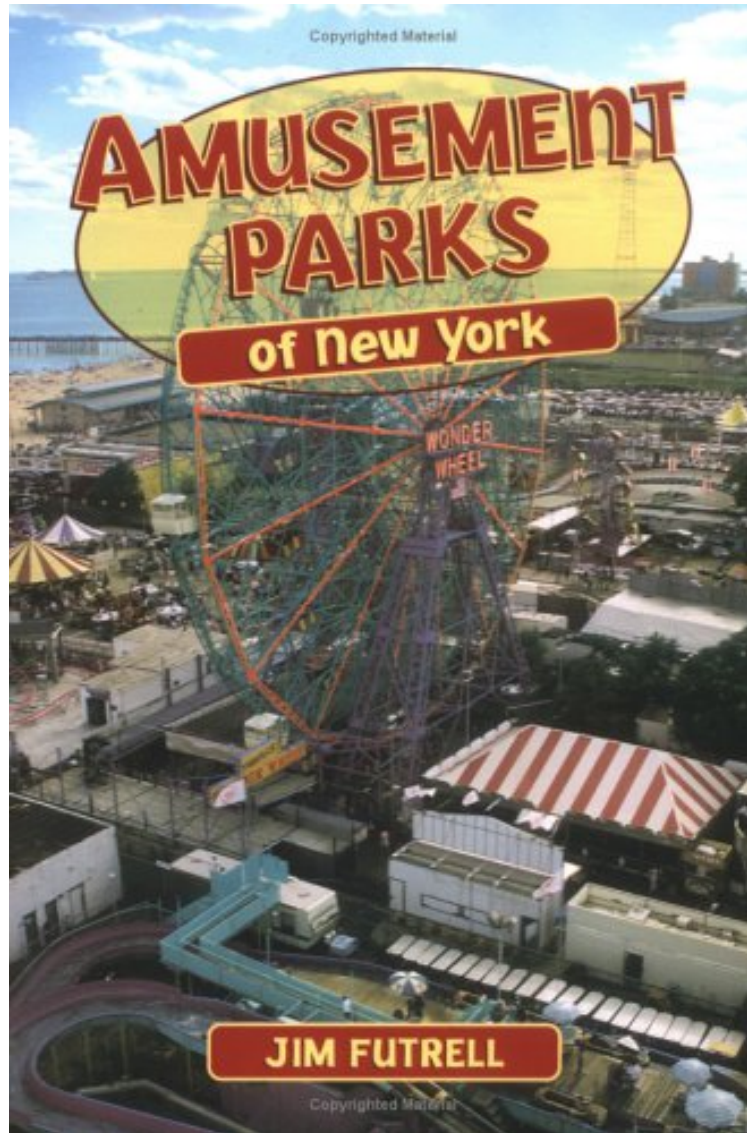

But the history alone makes this book worth reading. New York is where the amusement industry began in the United States, and the chapters on Coney Island tell the tale of

how it all began with plenty of detail and facts; all without losing the reader's attention. And then you have Playland in Rye, which is the first master-planned amusement park.
