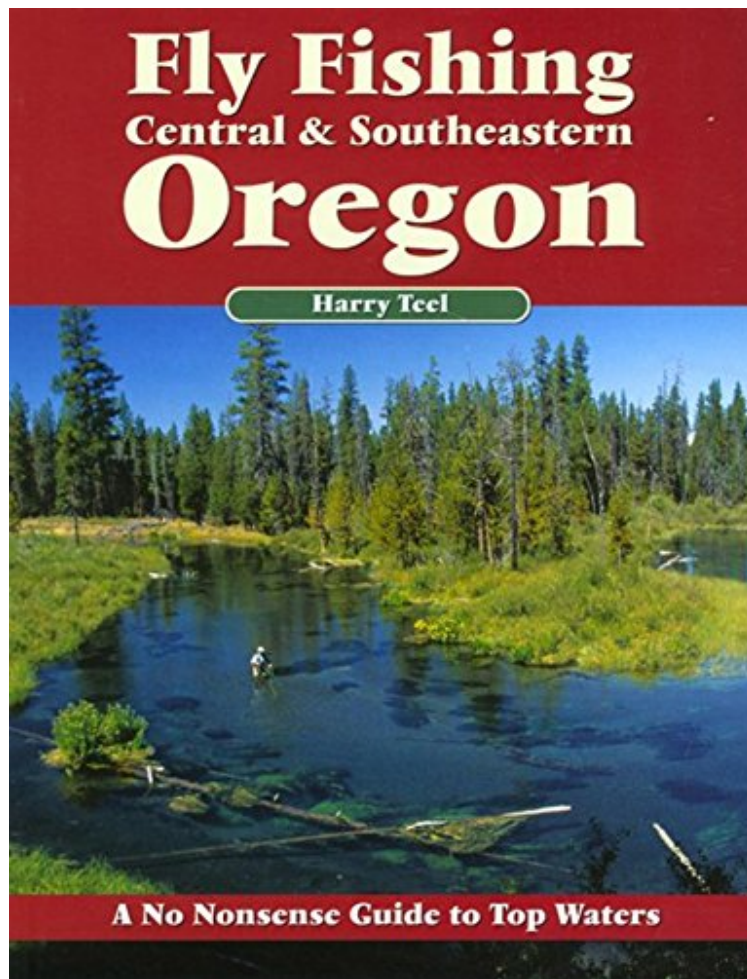

It offers no specifics regarding access or locations. A very general guide and not likely to benefit anglers unfamiliar with these areas. All of the information contained is readily available via the internet or a more comprehensive resource such as the Anglers' Guide to Oregon or the various hatch guides specific to the areas. It frankly isn't clear that the authors ever have specifically fished the
