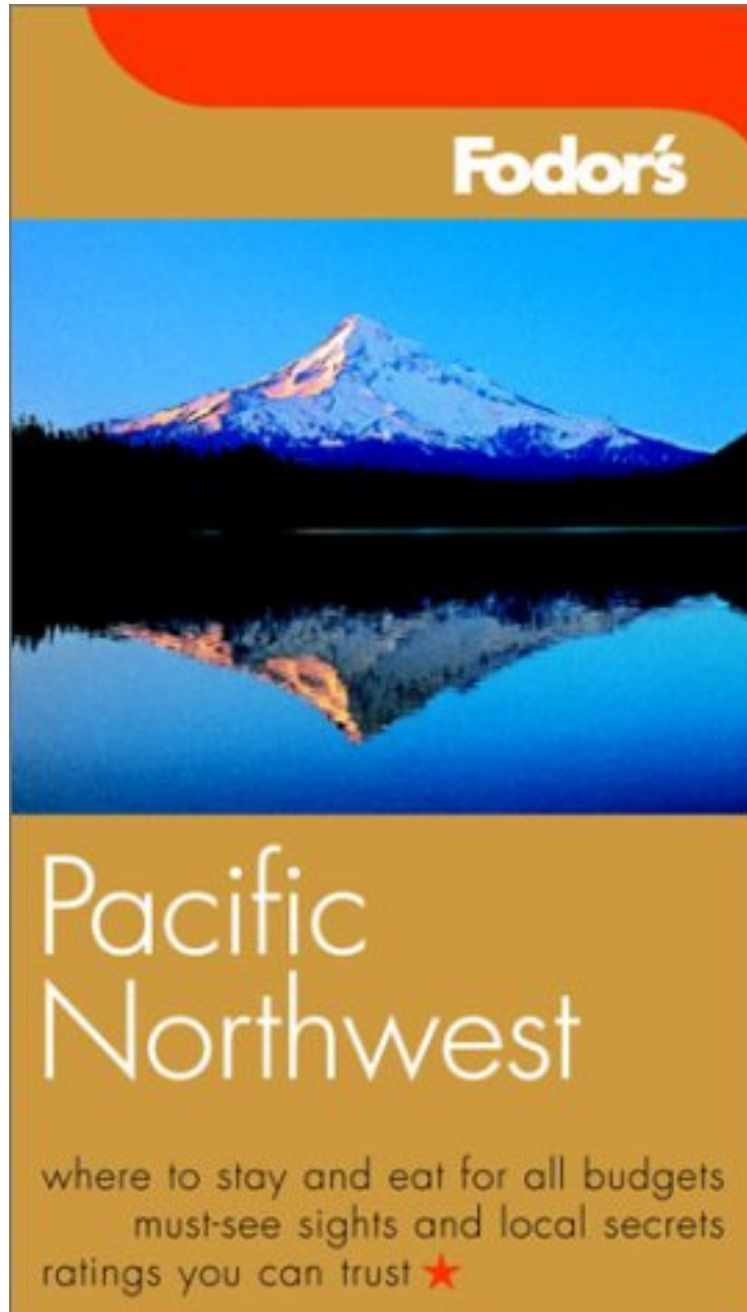

I found this guide to be extremely helpful both before and during my travels. I was impressed that I was able to find information other than the typical, popular tourist attractions in the main parts of each city. I also liked that they highlighted the "bests" of each city, as well as recommended activities based on your length of stay. I was slightly disappointed with the lack of information in the "Whistler, BC" and the quality of the maps (only in Black and White, and only a few neighborhoods for each city.) I think these shortcomings are minor, and would highly recommend it.

Rainier enchants commuters stuck in traffic; in Vancouver, British Columbia, the Coast Range juts out over downtown; and in Portland, 5,000 acres of forestland north of the city center harbor deer, elk, and the odd bear and cougar.
