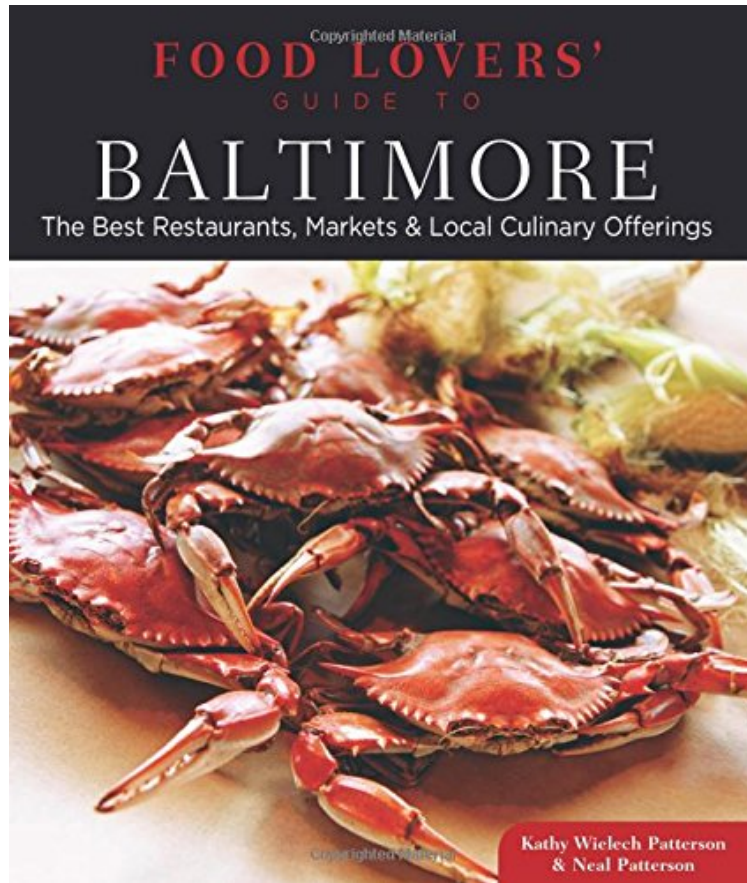

Baltimore City and county are divided into 14 areas. Some restaurants `worth the drive' are in a separate section, but are just listed alphabetically by restaurant; you have to search for an area by leafing through the pages. In the Baltimore section - each is separated by 'faves', restaurants that are landmarks and then specialty stores and markets. This is a great way to look for restaurants and places to eat. There are maps, but the restaurants are not marked on them. Something is told about each area. Each restaurant has the address, telephone number, web site, food type and general cost. There is quite a bit told about each place. The book also has several

pages describing web sites and a list of food festivals. Inserted are some interesting tidbits about Baltimore treats...Goetze's Caramel crmes, Smith Island cakes, picking crabs. I do wish they would have included more about Berger cookies; they are coveted by many across the country, even used as bets by public officials against other cities for sports events.
