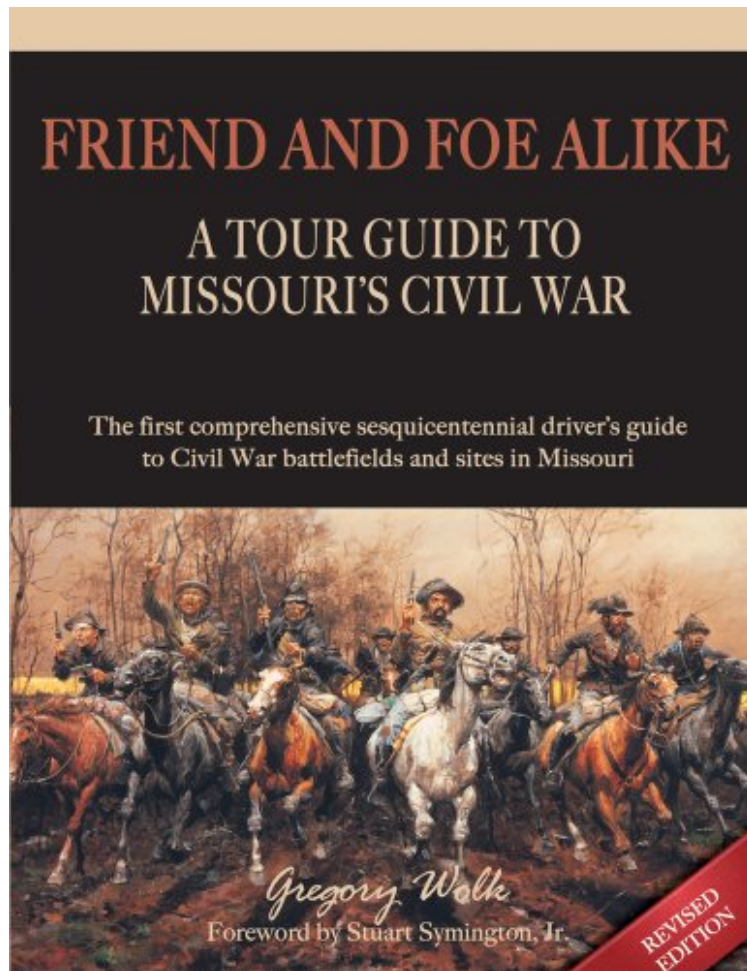

The book contains a lot of good information about Missouri Civil War sites, but I recommend that you buy a map along with the book. Unbelievably, there is no overall map of the state included in the book and you have to flip and flip and flip to find the partial maps that are spread throughout the book. There is no list of battles. The other problem is that the index is quite poor. For example, one of the most significant battles in the state was Wilson's Creek, which does not appear in the index at all.
