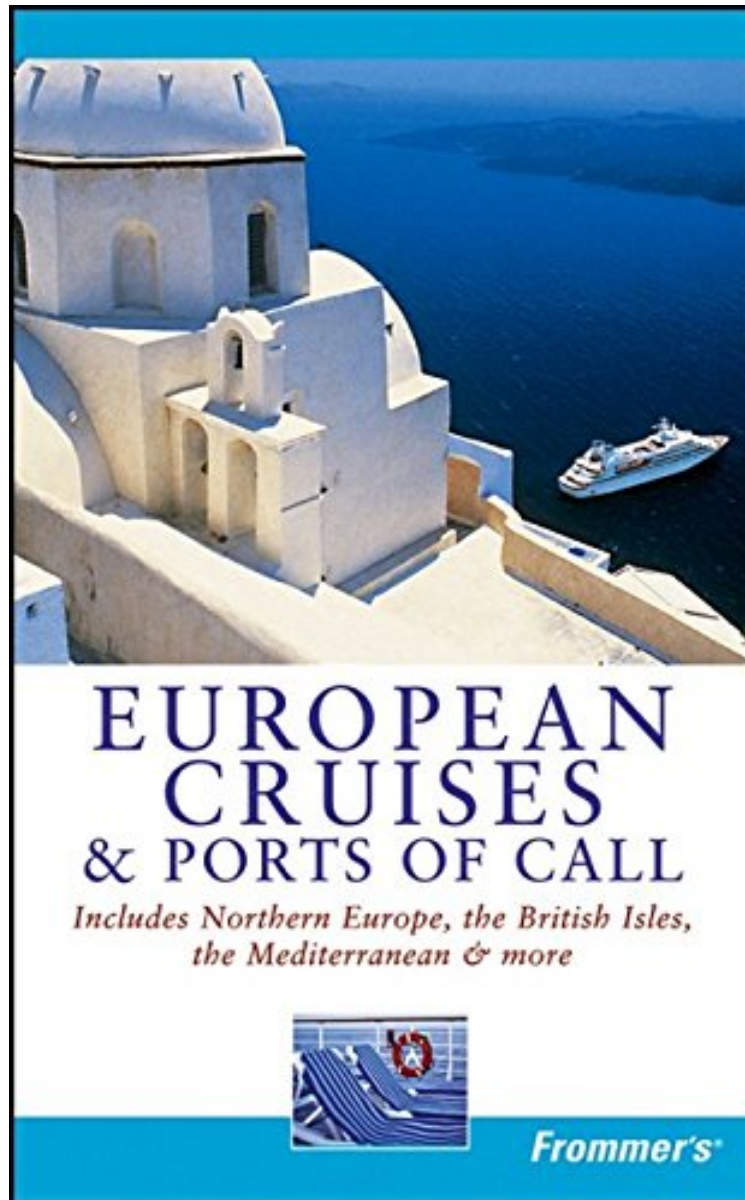

The port info is very surface level.
