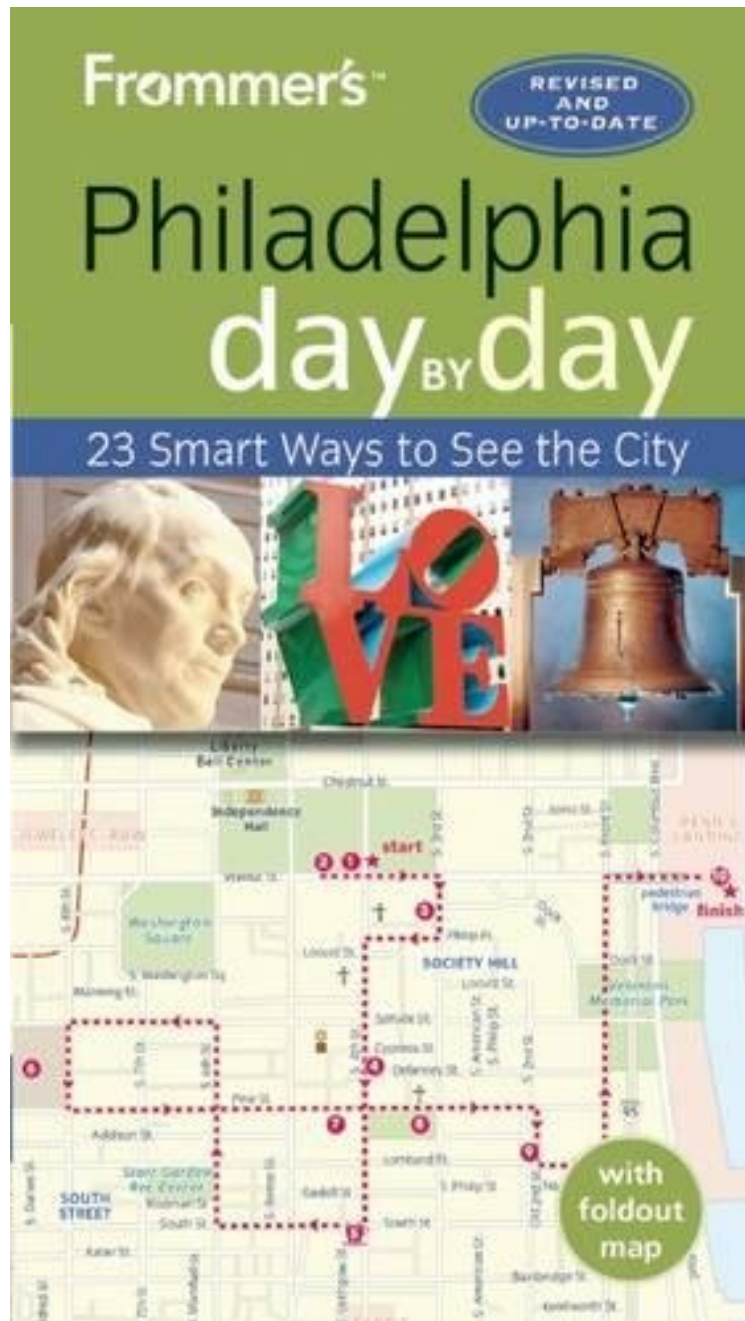

Cross-referencing is inconvenient, there's no easy way to jump to the maps, you can't jump from a border location on the edge of one map to a connecting map, etc. It's a missed opportunity, although I can easily imagine it would be a very expensive process to do a good job of transforming the book into a really good interactive book.My suggestion would be to skip the kindle version and just buy it on paper.
