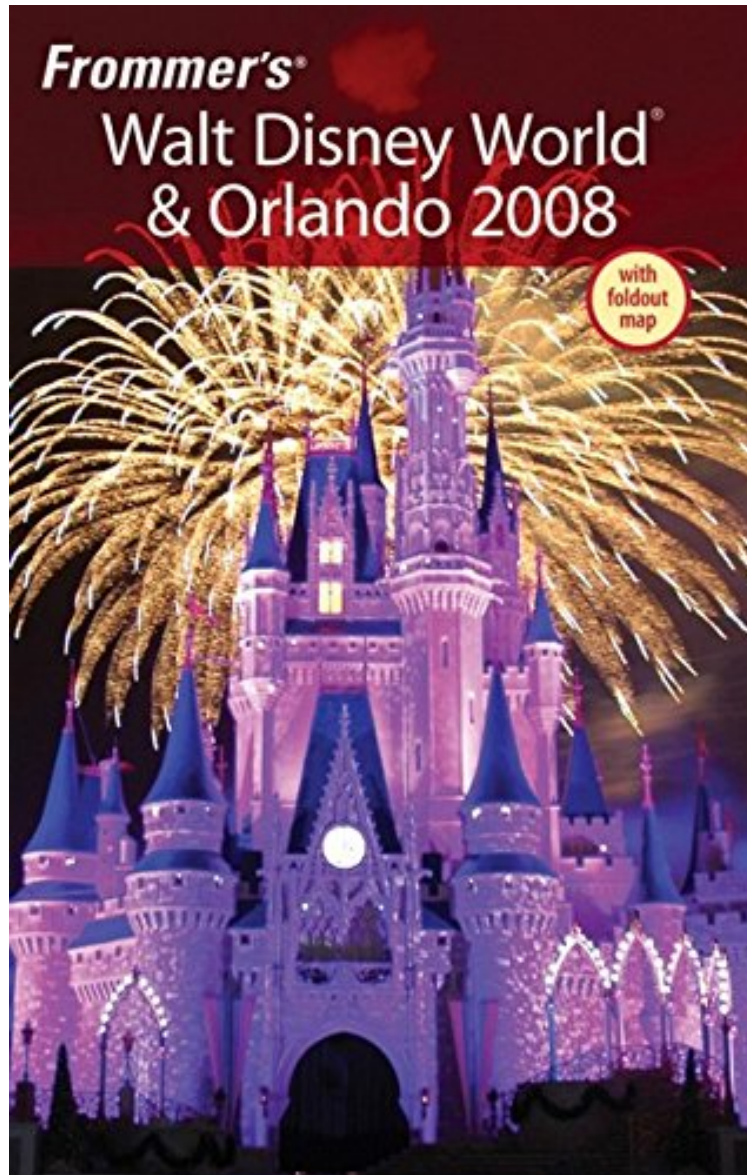

Great planning resource By law student My husband and I just went to Orlando for 4 days, and with the use of this guide, we were able to see the Magic Kingdom, Epcot, Animal Kingdom, Disney-MGM, Sea World, and Discovery Cove in those 4 days without feeling like we missed anything. We especially liked the 1-day planning guides for each park, which tell you what you must see if you only have one day at any particular Disney park (we were able to use these to see both Magic Kingdom and Epcot in one day, but keep in mind we have no kids in tow and we move fast!).
