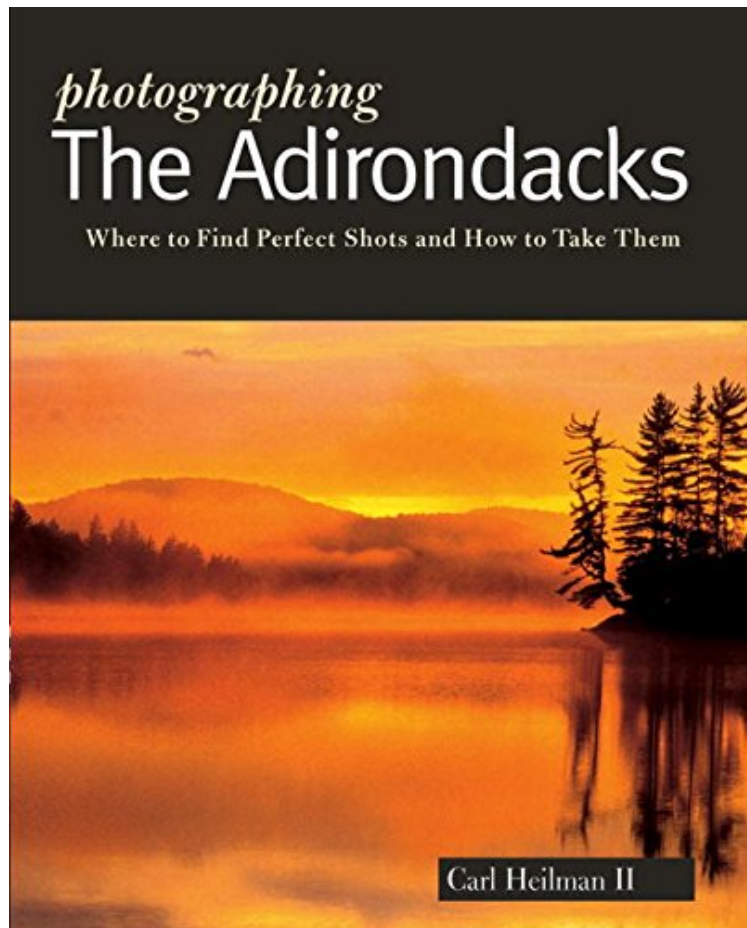

There are parts of the Adirondacks that I know very well, others that I know fairly well -- and then there are vastly more parts that I would never be able to discover at all without the help of this book. Carl Heilman II has lived and worked in the Adirondacks forever. He has had the opportunity to find and photograph everything from the well-known iconic places to the obscure ones. Now he generously shares his knowledge with us, offering descriptions of the places, directions on how to get there, suggestions for what to photograph and how, including the best times of day. In brief, he has saved you and me a lot of time and a great deal of legwork. Whether you've never been and are planning a trip to the Adirondacks or, like me, you have your repertoire of favorite places built up over the years and are eager to try something new, this is a great book, well worth the investment. Please note that this is not a book of technical advice

on how to take photographs. It happens too often that someone will review a book like this negatively because the author has not done what he never intended to do in the book.
