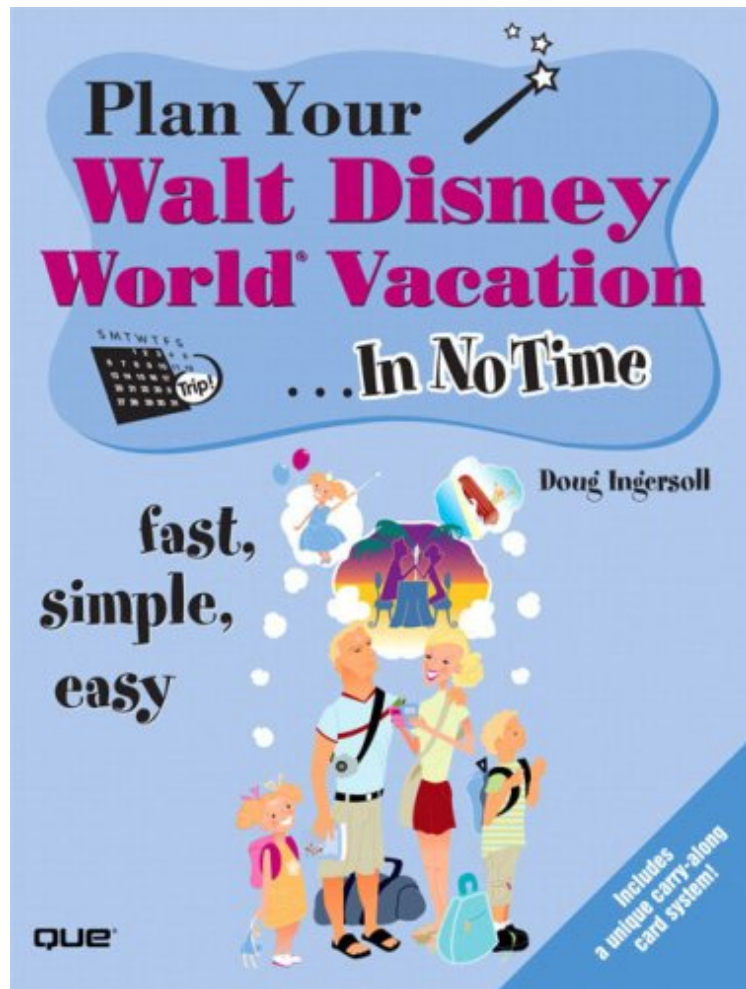

With so many attractions, planning ahead has become a Walt Disney World vacation requirement. So how do you decide what to do? That is what this book is all about helping you do, quickly and easily! In two easy steps, you will be ready to enjoy the wide range of fun that is Walt Disney World, and leave knowing that you made the most of your time. So what are these two magical steps? The first is planning the broader details of your vacation, such as where you are going to stay, and how you are going to get to Central Florida. This is covered in Part I of the book. You check the rides that you want to go on, X-out those you do not, and leave the maybes blank. The Trip Cards give you a fast, easy, portable guide to what you want to do and see in each of the Walt Disney World parks. So, to summarize the book's three parts: Part I, "Plan The Trip," guides you through the basics of picking the time of your trip, the hotel where you will stay, and other trip essentials including admissions ticket options, restaurant suggestions, and vacation planning resources. Part II, "Previewing the Parks," walks you through the four theme parks of Walt Disney World, including the attractions, entertainment and shopping options, and other relevant information.
