By the time it was my turn to be introduced to Mickey and Minnie I could feel the tightness in my throat as the tender emotions of reminiscences swept over me. I shared the memory with Mickey and Minnie and told them how they'd played a key role in making a little girl very happy on her birthday. And how happy the recollection made me again that day more than fifty years later. With merely the nod of their heads and without saying a word- they took both of my hands into their massive white gloved hands and let me know they understood and were happy for me.
