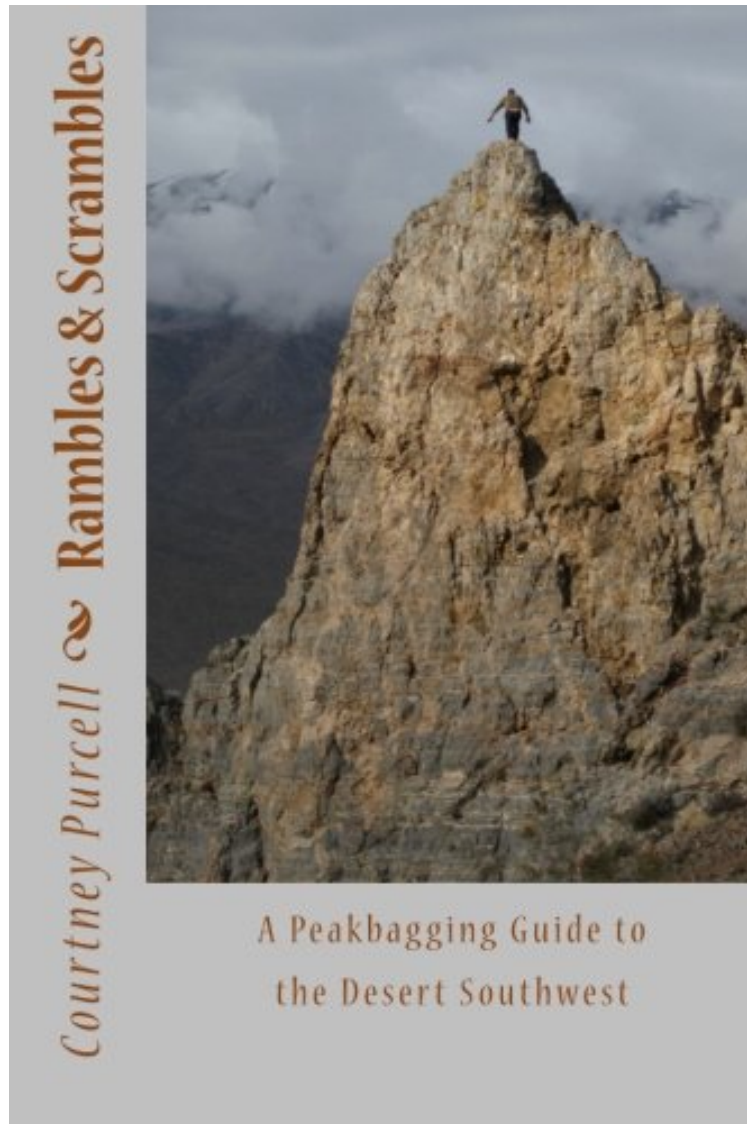

While most hiking books focus on holding your hand through simple local hikes, most of the descriptions in this book provide minimal information (GPS coordinates, a brief synopsis of the route, the difficulty of the different routes and how enjoyable the hike was to the author). This really lets you get the full experience while you're out there. You get to do your own route-finding to these often remote places and you get to stand where few have been before. I can't recommend this book enough! A special treat are the 'ticklists' at the end of the book, so you can check off the peaks as you bag 'em.
